Enclosed is an Order of Default entered by the Commission on September 13, 2018, revoking your license/certification to conduct gambling activities. This action occurred because you failed to attend the prehearing conference held on August 1, 2018.

You have the right to move to vacate this Order. If you do so, we must receive your request by the 10<sup>th</sup> day after the Order was mailed. Your motion must include the specific grounds upon which relief is requested and must be submitted to:

You also have the right to submit a Petition for Judicial Review. If you do this, you must submit it within 30 days of the date the Order was mailed. RCW 34.05.514 explains where you must file this petition and RCW 34.05.546 explains what information your Petition must include.

FINAL ORDER OF THE  
GAMBLING COMMISSION

Licensee.

This matter having come before the Washington State Gambling Commission (Commission) on September 13, 2018 and the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and issues its Final Order:

**I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. The Washington State Gambling Commission issued Licensee Quinton D. Jordan License number: 68-34672, authorizing Public Card Room Employee activity at Roxy’s Bar and Grill in Seattle, Washington.
- 2. This license, which expires on January 27, 2019, was issued subject to the licensee's compliance with state gambling laws and Commission rules at all times after receiving his gambling license.
- 3. Mr. Jordan first received his gambling license in January 2018.
- 4. Mr. Jordan’s gambling license application required him to disclose all possible criminal history, but Mr. Jordan did not disclose his criminal history on his application.

1           5.       Mr. Jordan signed his application by affirming the following: “I declare under  
2 penalty of perjury, under the laws of the state of Washington, that all information provided in  
3 this application is true and complete to the best of my knowledge. I understand that untruthful,  
4 misleading, or incomplete answers whether through misrepresentation, concealment,  
5 inadvertence, or mistake, are cause for denial of an initial application or revocation of any  
6 gambling license...”

7           6.       Mr. Jordan did not disclose his convictions for felony possession of a controlled  
8 substance in King County Superior Court Case Number 05-1-10851-3 in 2006, and resisting  
9 arrest in King County District Court Number 211189945 in 2011.

10          7.       Director David Trujillo issued administrative charges on April 30, 2018 alleging  
11 that Mr. Jordan’s actions constituted a violation of WAC 230-03-085. Further, that he could not  
12 show by clear and convincing evidence that he was qualified for licensure as required by RCW  
13 9.46.153(1), and that his actions warranted revocation of his license pursuant to RCW  
14 9.46.075(1), (3), (4), (7), and (8), and WAC 230-03-085(1), (3), (7) and (9)(a)and (b) (Previously  
15 WAC 230-03-085(a) and (b) (2017)).

16          8.       Mr. Jordan was sent the charges by regular and certified mail on May 1, 2018, to  
17 the last address the Gambling Commission had on file. The Commission received a request for  
18 hearing on May 18, 2018. A prehearing conference was scheduled for August 1, 2018, and Mr.  
19 Jordan was sent notice of the prehearing to the last address the Gambling Commission had on  
20 file on July 13, 2018.

21          9.       Mr. Jordan failed to attend the August 1, 2018 prehearing conference, and an  
22 order dismissing appeal was issued on August 2, 2018 to Mr. Jordan’s last address on file.

23          10.       To date, the Commission has received no further communication from Mr.  
24 Jordan.

1 **II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

2 1. Mr. Quinton D. Jordan was sent proper notice of the April 30, 2018 charges via  
3 first class mail and certified mail on May 1, 2018 pursuant to RCW 34.05.434, RCW 34.05.431,  
4 and WAC 10-08-130.

5 2. On August 1, 2018, Mr. Jordan failed to attend or participate in a hearing or other  
6 stage of an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.440(2).

7 3. The Commission can take final action against Mr. Jordan's gambling license  
8 under Case Number CR 2018-00539 pursuant to RCW 9.46.075, RCW 34.05.440(2), RCW  
9 34.05.461, and WAC 230-03-085.

10 4. Mr. Jordan's license should be revoked under Case Number CR 2018-00539  
11 pursuant to RCW 9.46.075, RCW 34.05.440(2), RCW 34.05.461, and WAC 230-03-085.


12 **ORDER**

**NOTICE**

1  
2        Reconsideration: RCW 34.05.470 and WAC 230-17-140 provide that a party may file a  
3 petition for reconsideration of a final order. A petition for reconsideration must be received no  
4 later than thirteen (13) days after the date this final order is mailed. Any motion for  
5 reconsideration must state the specific grounds supporting the party's request for  
6 reconsideration.

7        Stay of Final Order: Filing for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this  
8 Order. WAC 230-17-145 provides that a party may petition the Commission for a stay of a final  
9 order. Any petition for a stay should be received by the Commission within thirteen (13) days  
10 after the date this final order is mailed.

11        Judicial Review: RCW 34.05.542 provides that a party may appeal this final order by  
12 filing a petition for judicial review within thirty (30) days after service of this order. A petition  
13 for judicial review must be filed with the appropriate superior court and served upon both the  
14 Commission and the Office of the Attorney General.

15        Service: This Order was served on you three days after it was deposited in the United  
16 States Postal Service regular mail, excluding the date of mailing. WAC 230-17-035.


