Enclosed is an Order of Default entered by the Commission on October 18, 2018, revoking your license/certification to conduct gambling activities. This action occurred because you did not timely respond by requesting a hearing to the administrative charges filed on July 27, 2018 against your gambling license/certification.

You have the right to move to vacate this Order. If you do so, we must receive your request by the 10<sup>th</sup> day after the Order was mailed. Your motion must include the specific grounds upon which relief is requested and must be submitted to:

You also have the right to submit a Petition for Judicial Review. If you do this, you must submit it within 30 days of the date the Order was mailed. RCW 34.05.514 explains where you must file this petition and RCW 34.05.546 explains what information your Petition must include.

FINAL ORDER OF THE  
GAMBLING COMMISSION

Licensee.

This matter having come before the Washington State Gambling Commission (Commission) on October 18, 2018, the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and issues its Final Order:

**I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Washington State Gambling Commission issued Licensee Meisean Teurn License number: 68-34110, authorizing Public Card Room Employee activity at Freddie’s Club in Renton and Great American Casino in Des Moines, Washington.

2. This license, which expires on March 27, 2019, was issued subject to the licensee's compliance with state gambling laws and Commission rules at all times after receiving her gambling license.

3. On January 31, 2018, Ms. Teurn was indicted in the United States District Court for the District of Montana, Missoula Division, with three felonies: one count of Conspiracy to

1 Possess with Intent to Distribute Oxycodone, one count of Fraudulent Acquisition of  
2 Oxycodone, and one count of Conspiracy to Attempt Fraudulent Acquisition of Oxycodone.

3 4. Ms. Teurn chose not to notify the Gambling Commission of the felony charges  
4 on her March 26, 2018 renewal application.

5 5. On June 19, 2018, Ms. Teurn pled guilty to Conspiracy to Possess with Intent to  
6 Distribute Oxycodone.

7 6. Ms. Teurn never disclosed the charges or her conviction to the Gambling  
8 Commission.

9 7. Director David Trujillo issued a summary suspension and administrative charges  
10 on July 23, 2018 alleging that Ms. Tuern's actions constituted a violation of WAC 230-06-  
11 085(1). Further, that she could not show by clear and convincing evidence that she was qualified  
12 for licensure as required by RCW 9.46.153(1), and that her actions warranted revocation of her  
13 license pursuant to RCW 9.46.075(1), (2), (4), (7), and (8), and WAC 230-03-085(1), (7) and  
14 (9)(a)and (b) (Previously WAC 230-03-085(8)(a) and (b) (2017)).

15 8. Ms. Teurn was personally served the summary suspension and charges on July  
16 27, 2018.

17 9. To date, the Commission has received no communication from Ms. Teurn.

## 18 II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

19 1. Ms. Meisean Teurn was served proper notice of the July 23, 2018 charges on July  
20 27, 2018 pursuant to RCW 34.05.434, RCW 34.05.431, and WAC 10-08-130.

21 2. The Commission can take final action against Ms. Teurn's gambling license  
22 under Case Number CR 2018-01076 pursuant to RCW 9.46.075, RCW 34.05.440(1), RCW  
23 34.05.461, and WAC 230-03-085.

24 3. Ms. Teurn's license should be revoked under Case Number CR 2018-01076  
25 pursuant to RCW 9.46.075, RCW 9.46.153(1), WAC 230-06-085(1), RCW 34.05.440(1), RCW  
26 34.05.461, and WAC 230-03-085.

**ORDER**

This matter having come before the Commission at its October 18, 2018, Commission meeting, the Commissioners having heard arguments, been given the chance to review the administrative record, and being fully advised in this matter, now therefore:

It is hereby **ORDERED** that Meisean Teurn's gambling license, Number 68-34110, is **REVOKED**.

**NOTICE**

Reconsideration: RCW 34.05.470 and WAC 230-17-140 provide that a party may file a petition for reconsideration of a final order. A petition for reconsideration must be received no later than thirteen (13) days after the date this final order is mailed. Any motion for reconsideration must state the specific grounds supporting the party's request for reconsideration.

Stay of Final Order: Filing for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. WAC 230-17-145 provides that a party may petition the Commission for a stay of a final order. Any petition for a stay should be received by the Commission within thirteen (13) days after the date this final order is mailed.

Judicial Review: RCW 34.05.542 provides that a party may appeal this final order by filing a petition for judicial review within thirty (30) days after service of this order. A petition for judicial review must be filed with the appropriate superior court and served upon both the Commission and the Office of the Attorney General.

Service: This Order was served on you three days after it was deposited in the United States Postal Service regular mail, excluding the date of mailing. WAC 230-17-035.


